

3. At present teaching staff are being appointed on contract basis in the Institutions run by A.P.S.W.R.E.I.S. To have parity and also to have proper accountability of the teaching staff and to have academic excellence of students studying in Tribal Welfare Department the appointments to the posts of teachers in Tribal Welfare Residential Schools shall be on contract basis on the terms and conditions as approved by the A.P.S.W.R.E.I.S

4. The following posts of Non-teaching staff are hereby sanctioned as per the approved staffing pattern:

5. Besides extending the catering services on contract basis as in the case of APSWRES, the following services may be engaged on contract basis:

- (a) Electrical and plumbing services.
- (b) Sanitation services.

(c) Watch and Ward can also be tried through the schools are located in very interior areas. Such private arrangement may be made with the concerned persons who are not always be available.

6. Sanction is hereby accorded to the Commissioner of Tribal Welfare, Hyderabad for incurring an expenditure of Rs. 115.00 lakhs (Rupees one hundred and fifteen lakhs only) towards establishment of seven Residential Schools for S.Ts, at the places mentioned above. The amount sanctioned shall be drawn in relaxation of quarterly regulation orders.
